Course Outline/ Course Objectives (授業の概要・到達目標)

Objectives of the class: to understand the characteristics and background of emerging and reemerging infectious diseases.

Objectives of the class: the purpose of this course is to understand an overview of emerging and re-emerging infectious diseases, and to describe current issues.

Outline of the class: emerging infectious diseases are defined as "infectious diseases caused by pathogens that have been newly identified in the past 20 years, are increasing in incidence, or are likely to threaten human life in the future," including COVID-19 and Ebola virus diseases. Re-emerging infectious diseases are "infectious diseases that existed in the past and have become almost a non-issue in public health, but have increased again in recent years or may become a problem again in the future," such as resistant bacterial infections and rabies. These characteristics and backgrounds will be presented. The actual conditions and pathogenesis of infectious diseases, and appropriate diagnostic and therapeutic methods will be discussed.
