### 3. Course Description Outline(Course Objectives)

The main purpose of this course is to become more comfortable with English in a variety of health and medical situations, and to think about health-related issues from a variety of perspectives. Basically, the course will be divided into three parts: (1) reading, analyzing, and discussing articles on health and medicine, (2) watching and discussing an ethnographic film (in relation to disease prevention and the provision of health care in other parts of the world), and (3) reading and reporting on articles chosen by the students. The point of the course is to learn about health, disease, and treatment in a global context.

### 4. Textbook/Reference Books

The instructor will prepare the materials. Students will also be required to find at least one article by themselves. We will discuss this on the first day of class. For more information, knock on D. Wood's office door, or e-mail at wood@med.akita-u.ac.jp, or call at 884-6244.

### 5. Assessment
